

Cartel Court confirms fine against STRABAG

In July 2021, STRABAG SE announced that group companies STRABAG AG and F. Lang u. K. Menhofer Baugesellschaft m.b.H. & Co. KG had issued an acknowledgement as part of a settlement in the antitrust proceedings against them, upon which the BWB filed an application with the Cartel Court for a fine. The acknowledgement and the full cooperation with the BWB had a correspondingly positive effect on the amount of the fine.
